

History

- In 2012, Bishop Boyea (Lansing) was asked to consider hosting a women's conference for the Lansing Diocese.
- Lansing has sponsored a yearly conference almost every year since then.
- Other diocese (AOD, Kalamazoo) have also had a history of diocesan-wide conferences.
- In 2021, the first state-wide Michigan Catholic Women's Conference was held and over 1000 women attended in both 2021 and 2022.


