History

- In 2012, Bishop Boyea (Lansing) was asked to consider hosting a women's conference for the Lansing Diocese.
- Lansing has sponsored a yearly conference almost every year since then.
- Other diocese (AOD, Kalamazoo) have also had a history of diocesan-wide conferences.
- In 2021, the first state-wide Michigan Catholic Women's Conference was held and over 1,000 women have attended the last 3 years.

- We will remind the women about the faithfulness of God throughout all generations. In a world where there are so many lies and confusion, we can be assured of the true treasure of God's promises to us. Let us hold fast to these promises and be constant in faith.
- 2) Out of His Great Love for us, Jesus redeemed us in His passion and death and promises new life in His Resurrection. He is the Way, the Truth and the Life. We will learn how we can give our whole hearts to Him in trust and surrender.

- 4) We will learn to recognize God's faithfulness in the story of our lives and learn that when we share our story, we make Jesus present, true and real to those around us.

Frequently Asked Questions

- Does our church receive a packet of information and printed flyers?
 - No All flyers and posters and other marketing materials are posted on the <u>website</u> for parishes to print in house
- When should we approach our Pastor about promoting the conference and announcing the conference to the Parish?
 - As soon as possible
- What if we know of people who would like to attend but cannot afford to attend? What about religious sisters – do they get a discount?
 - Sponsorships can go toward scholarships for hardship. Ask your parishioners or groups to provide scholarships.
